Please read section 43A(1)&(2) of the Arms Act 1983 for laws relating to mail order or Internet sales of arms items or ammunition. Date of application New Zealand has a new Firearms Registry. If you're a firearms licence holder, you have until 24 June 2028 to register your firearms. However, there are activating circumstances when you're required to provide information to the Registry within a shorter time frame. To find out how and when to register your firearms, go to firearmssafetyauthority.govt.nz/registry. - 2. You may not take possession of any non-prohibited firearm, non-prohibited magazine, non-prohibited part, ammunition and/or pistol carbine conversion kit unless you have a current firearms or dealer licence.
- 3. If you are purchasing an airgun, you need to be 18 years of age or older if you do not have a firearms licence.
